Re: School Meal Reminder

I am writing to remind home of the importance to inform the main office of any one-off, temporary or permanent changes to your child's school meal plan.

As part of the admission process, parents are asked to specify their child's meal plan (i.e., school meals or packed lunch) and this information is entered onto our MIS system. This information is shared with our school kitchen to ensure that the ordering of supplies and preparing of meals is accurate.

The administrative team run daily reports and, although the kitchen allow for a proportion of unplanned changes, I am sure you can appreciate the impact this has on the kitchen and lunchtime staff, the other children and the administrative team.

I understand that there are times when changes cannot be planned for, and informing the main office can be easily forgotten amid a busy morning. Be that as it may, I am asking for your support to tell the main office as soon as possible; either face-to-face or via telephone on 01902 556350 or via email on office@wodensfield.org

Our expectation is that school meals are to be paid in advance via the School Gateway app. A school meal is £2.40 per day unless your child is entitled to Free School Meals. Please note, all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to Universal Infant Free School Meals (UNIFSM).
