## Things to Note

- School uniform must be worn on days when the children are not required to wear PE/Games kit. PE/Games kit must be worn on days when the children have PE or Forest School. - Please continue to pay Cool Milk direct if your child is over 5 years-old and does not receive free milk <u>https://www.coolmilk.com/parents/</u>
- School meals to continue to be paid in advance via the School Gateway app. A school meal is £2.40 per day. You must inform the school office, should you wish to change your child's meal plan as you will be charged.
- Apple to continue to be paid in advance via the School Gateway app. Deadline to pay Apple money for Spring term is Friday 19<sup>th</sup> January 2024. Apple for the Summer term is also available to pay via School Gateway.

#### <u>Attendance</u>

School starts promptly at 8:40am. Infant staff will open doors to the building at this time and Junior staff will greet children on the playground. Any child who arrives after 8:50am must report to the main school office with a parent / carer. A late mark will be entered on the register, along with the reason for lateness.

**\*\* Important reminder:** the texting service will cease to operate by February half-term. Therefore, it is vital parents allow push notifications on their mobile device. This can be accessed via your device settings. It is also important to note that parents do not need to log out of the app.
