Dear Parents and Carers,

School Meals

Collection

As part of our ongoing commitment to safeguarding our pupils, we kindly remind you to inform the school of any changes to your child's collection arrangements.

For the safety and security of all children, the school will not release any pupil without prior arrangement. If there are any changes to who will be collecting your child, please notify the school office in advance.

Moments Matter, Attendance Counts

School starts promptly at 8:40am. Please note, children must not be left unattended on the school site before 8:40am. Infant staff will open doors to the building at this time and Junior staff will greet children on the playground. Any child who arrives after 8:50am must report to the main school office with a parent. A late mark will be entered on the register, along with the reason for lateness.

Due to an increase in children being taken out of school for appointments, please may I remind parents/carers that except for hospital appointments, all other appointments should be scheduled outside of school hours to minimize the impact on children's learning. Evidence will need to be provided for any appointments during school hours.
