HOW CAN YOU ENCOURAGE AND HELP YOUR CHILD TO BE READY TO COME TO SCHOOL IN THE MORNINGS?

- Make sure they understand the importance of good attendance and punctuality.
- Discuss any problems they may have at school- inform their teacher about any concerns or difficulties.
- It really helps to have everything ready for school the night before (bag packed, clothes ready etc)
- Spend a few minutes at the end of the day talking about what they are looking forward to.
- Make sure they have a good healthy breakfast.

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT?

We are passionate about attendance because being in school regularly really does matter!

Missing school is "missing out".

Research shows that regular absences have a very negative impact on children and how much progress they make.



Building habits of regular attendance ensures that your child enjoys all of the many benefits that school brings, such as,

opportunities for learning and making progress, as well as wider personal development opportunities like enjoying clubs and sport or creative activities.

Making connections everyday with other children and staff also builds belonging, which we believe is an essential component of a happy, healthy child.

There is a legal requirement to ensure children attend school regularly and arrive on time.

If your child is late for school 10 minutes every day they will miss 32 hours of

education, the equivalent to around 6 days of school!
