



***How can we find out about a Christian belief? Talking about God.***

Christianity	A religion based on the teachings of Jesus Christ.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Just because we can't see things doesn't mean they are not there – we can see the effects.</li> <li>We all experience “seeing” things in different ways.</li> <li>Christians believe that one of the characteristics of God is one of love.</li> <li>Another characteristic is God as Father.</li> <li>God is also portrayed as a Creator.</li> <li>There are 3 representations of God known as The Trinity.</li> <li>Christians use prayer as a way to communicate with God.</li> </ul> <div>   </div>
Trinity	The 3 representations of God – Father, Son and Holy Spirit	
Reflection	Giving an idea serious thought.	
Prayer	The act of talking to God.	
God	The creator of the world and everything else.
