William Morris (24th March 1834- 3rd Oct 1896)

- Born in England
- Textile designer

Pablo Picasso (25th October 1881 – 8th April 1973)

- Born in Spain
- Influenced by cubism, surrealism

Stone Age Art

- Most cave paintings date from 10,000 to 20,000 years ago
- Artists also created sculptures from clay, ivory, bone, or carved stone

Roman Art Mosaic

 Mosaics were made up of hundreds, sometimes thousands, of tiny coloured stones and gems called tesserae. Each mosaic piece was stuck to the floor with mortar, a type of cement. Mosaics would show pictures of Roman history and everyday Roman life.

Key Vocabulary

Cubism- is a style of art which aims to show all of the possible viewpoints of a person or an object all at once. It is

called Cubism because the items represented in the artworks look like they are made out of cubes and other geometrical shapes.

Surrealism-explored the subconscious areas of the mind. The artwork often made little sense as it was usually trying to depict a dream or random thoughts.
