Curriculum Newsletter

Summer 2018

Topics Covered

Over Summer Term

English

This term we will continue to develop writing skills. The children will be retelling traditional tales, writing a recount of our trip and writing their own poems. We will also focus on handwriting, forming letters correctly and improving presentation.

Maths

This term we will continue to work on numbers to 100. Within this we will consolidate their place value knowledge and move onto addition and subtraction within 100 too. We will also look at money, fractions, capacity and weight: all using a practical approach.

Science

We will be linking science to our topic of The Street, by looking at the different materials that are around us. Also, we will continue to observe the changes to the seasons, looking at spring and summer.

Computing

Children will continue to develop digital researcher skills in Geography when looking at maps and digital presenter skills in History, based on our trip to Blists Hill.

P.E.

Dance and Gym - the children will be creating a dance based on different animals.
Outdoor games - we will be focusing on striking a ball using a bat and practicing sports day events.

History

Our topic this term is The Street. We will be comparing Victorian houses and Victorian school life to our own. We will also be going to Blists Hill.

Geography

We will be investigating the variety of different buildings and houses in our local area and looking at maps of our local area.

In RE we will be exploring Christianity and God, then we will be learning about Sikhs.

Art

We will be developing different skills in art: drawing, weaving and making a 3D models. This will be linked to our topic and we will be making a 3D model of a house.
